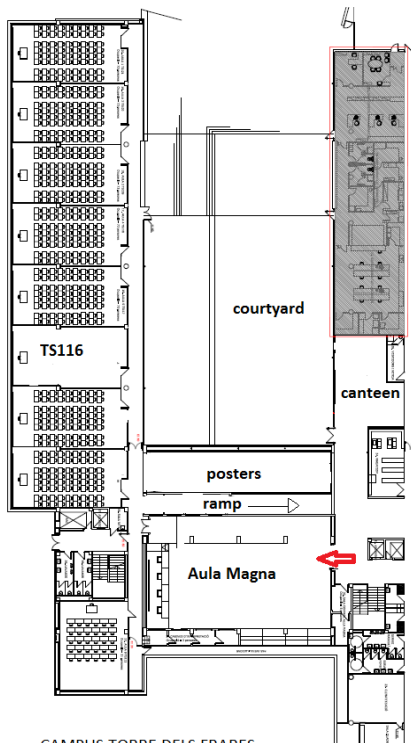

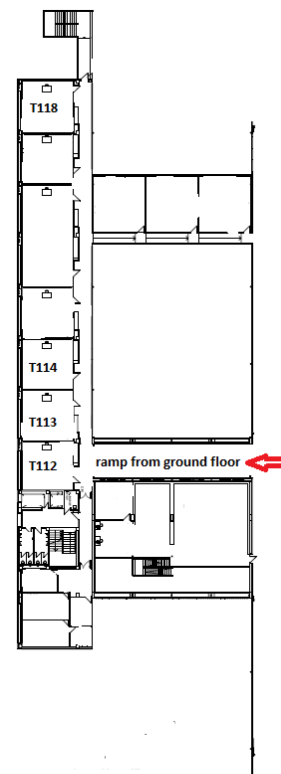
Campus Torre dels Frares: Floor Plans
