Vladimir Estivill-Castro (Griffith University, UPF visitor) Integration of Planing and Reasoning into an Architecture that Enables Model-Driven Development



Vladimir Estivill-Castro (<u>http://www.ict.griffith.edu.au/~vlad/</u>) is currently team leader of MI-PAL, who has participated in RoboCup 2011, RoboCup 2012 and RoboCup 2013 in the Standard Platform League using the Humanoid Robot Nao. His main interest are software engineering, algorithmic engineering, computational complexity, intelligent data analysis, privacy preserving data mining and knowledge discovery.

Prof. Estivill-Castro holds a Ph.D. from the University of Waterloo in Canada and degrees from UNAM in Mexico. He serves in the editorial board of the Journal of Research and Practice in Information Technology, is editor in chief of the series Conferences in Research

and Practice in Information Technology and serves on the editorial review board of the International Journal of Data Warehousing and Mining. Prof. Estivill-Castro is a scholar based at Griffith University in Australia but regularly visits the Universitat Pompeu Fabra in Spain

Her research interests range from robot kinematics, computer vision and neurocomputing, to geometric reasoning and manipulation planning.

Gala Dinner. In the modernist Salle at the Casino de Vic, hosted in the modernist Casa Comellas near the Old Market Square.












